Club Organisation

Lincoln Castle

The Lincoln Castle tournament is over 12/13 May this year and is slightly different than previously. The Saturday event is an open double tournament (I believe that the format is as in previous years) and the Sunday being a singles tournament for players with handicaps of 8 to 12. Nottingham Tournament

The Nottingham Club is holding a C level Golf Croquet tournament on the 30 May which is aimed at beginners and therefore restricted to those players with handicaps in the 8 to 12 range. There will be lunch and tea on offer and the tournament is to run from 10.00am to around 5.00pm. The format is to be mini leagues leading to a knock out competition. Entrants should get at least 6 games.
